



Anoka-Champlin Joint Powers Fire Board Special Meeting minutes

March 3, 2021

1. Call to order

The special meeting of the Anoka-Champlin Joint Powers Fire board was called to order by Nate Truesdell at 6PM in the Champlin Council Chambers.

4. Accept the appointment of Fire Chief Ted Massicotte

Greg Lee reviewed the 3rd round hiring process:

In June Chief Kline was hired for his leadership skills and to assist in the hiring process of a new Fire Chief-many thanks to Chief Kline for his time as the Interim Fire Chief

In August Chief Kline re-wrote the Fire Chief Job Requirements based on the needs of the Anoka-Champlin Fire Department. Both City Council's met with the Fire Board to discuss the hiring process

In October the hiring firm, ESCI was hired for \$15,000.00 to manage the hiring process

Upon the conclusion of the hiring process, Ted Massicotte was recommended for the Fire Chief position

On February 19th, 2021 an offer was made to Ted Massicotte and he accepted

March 15, 2021 will be Chief Massicotte's first day with a three day overlap with Chief Kline for information sharing

Greg Lee and the Operating Committee Recommend the appointment of Chief Massicotte as the new Fire Chief

Upon motion by Bret Heitkamp, and second by Chief Peterson, the Fire Board voted unanimously to approve Chief Massicotte as the new Anoka-Champlin Fire Chief.
